ARMY Selection

All armies will consist of up to 2,000 points using all current rules from the current General's Handbook set in Andtor.

We will be using Best Coast Pairings throughout the event and all lists must be submitted no later than **23:59 February 24th 2024.** Lists must be exported and formatted from either <u>Warscroll Builder</u> or the official GW Age of Sigmar App. Do not forget your triumph!!

All miniatures must be to a "battle ready" standard as outlined <u>here</u>. If you're unsure if your miniatures count as battle ready please get in touch with photos.



Rules, Battlescrole, FAQs and errata

We will be using the latest Battlescroll and FAQ's available from Warhammer Community as well as any other matched play legal book released up to February 24th.

All miniatures must also be on their correct base size. Conversions are great and cool but please make sure that your miniature is easily identifiable and on the right size base. If you're unsure about your conversions please email in with photos. Please specify in the subject line GHO AOS Query when you do!

Rules queries

If you're unsure about any rules interactions or how we will be ruling any particular niche interactions of your army please email in and specify in the subject line GHO AOS Rules Query when you do. All publications issued by Games Workshop until list submission on Feb 24th 2024 23:59 will be used.

What you need to bring

- 3. Dice, measuring tapes, markers, and other paraphernalia

Terrain

All mats and terrain will of course be provided, each table will have 8 pieces of terrain. These will include impassable, line of sight blocking, and garrisonable pieces (please make sure you're read up on how these work!) on each table. Tables will have maps provided on the day and players should adhere to these as best as possible, if the terrain and objective layout means a player is unable to play their faction terrain then move the terrain pieces as short of a distance as possible so it fits. If this is still an issue please come and get a judge.

Mysterious Terrain is up to the players in each game. If either player wants to use it then it will be used. If both players agree to forego mysterious terrain then feel free to leave it!








Finding the Venue and Parking
